In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee grants recognition to **Ramakrishna Mission Brahmananda College of Education, Rahara, North 24 Parganas, West Bengal** for **B.Ed. Course** of one year duration from the academic session 2002-2003 with an annual intake of **80 (Eighty)** students, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:

1. The institution shall appoint / function with 7 teaching staff and supporting staff possessing the qualifications as laid down in the NCTE norms before the commencement of academic session 2002-2003, in the salary structure prescribed by the UGC/Central Government/ State Government as the case may be.
2. All such teachers already appointed who do not fulfil the NCTE norms shall acquire the qualifications as per the norms within a period of two years of this order.
3. The institution shall ensure library, Journals, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per the NCTE norms.
4. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating university/ State Government.
5. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating university/State Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
6. Curriculum transaction including practical work/activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating university/examining body.
7. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
8. The institution, being private and unaided, shall maintain endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs under the joint operation with the Officer of ERC, NCTE in the Nationalized Bank within one month from the date of receipt of this Order and reserve fund of three months salary as per NCTE norms.
9. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Performance Appraisal Report within 45 days of the last examination/academic session every year. The Performance Appraisal Report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated at 1 to 8 above.

If **Ramakrishna Mission Brahmananda College of Education, Rahara, North 24 Parganas, West Bengal** contravenes any of the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder, or fails to fulfil the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

ORDER

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS** the institution viz. **Ramakrishna Mission Brahmananda College of Education, Rahara, North 24 Parganas, West Bengal-743186** was granted recognition for conduct of **B.Ed.** course of **one** year duration with an annual intake of **80** from the **academic session 2002-2003** vide ERC order no. **ERC/ 7-23/ 2002/ 1134 dt.12.04.2002.**

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution viz. Ramakrishna Mission Brahmananda College of Education, Rahara, North 24 Parganas, West Bengal-743186 has by affidavit dated **27.01.2015** consented to come under New Regulations 2014 and sought **for One Basic Unit in B.Ed. course.**

4. **AND WHEREAS**, it has been decided to permit the institution to have One Basic Unit of 50 students subject to fulfilling following conditions, namely,

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Loan raising against or mortgaging of FDR's shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

5. **Now therefore**, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3) (a) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Ramakrishna Mission Brahmananda College of Education, Rahara, North 24 Parganas, West Bengal-743186** for conducting **B.Ed.** Programme of **two** years duration with an intake of 50 for One Basic Unit of 50 students from the academic session **2015-2016**.

6. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of other requirements as may be prescribed by NCTE from time to time and other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

8. The institutions shall maintain & update its web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution:
- b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
- d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.:
- e) Fee charged from students;
- f) Available infrastructural facilities;
- g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information. If it so desires.
- k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
